







# **Designed for Reception and Year 1**

# Decide on how you would like to train

#### Option 1 - Whole school training of all sessions.

Starting in reception children will attend a first aid session every other year. They will never repeat a session and leave primary school having learnt a range of basic lifesaving skills.
